

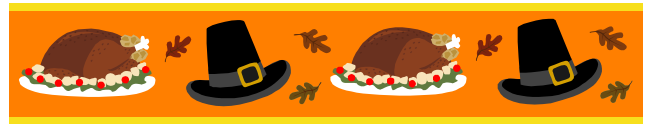

## Heating With Wood / Firewood Permits

Personal use firewood permits are \$10.00 per cord with a minimum purchase of 2 cords per permit and a maximum of 12 cords per person per year. Firewood permits include the firewood cutting regulations along with firewood tags and a firewood-cutting map.

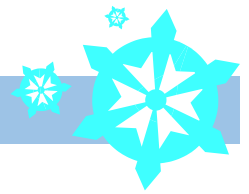

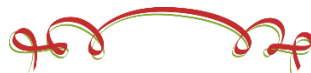

### Temporary Cold Weather Shelters—“Warming Centers”

During extreme cold or freezing, certain buildings in Butte County may be designated as “warming centers” for people without warm shelter.
